


# Faith Formation 2017-2018

## First Day of Class Information & Parent Orientation

If your child attends class on Sundays at 4 p.m., Mondays at 3:30 p.m. or Tuesdays at 4:30 p.m. please attend the Parent Welcome Orientation (after dropping your child off to class).

This meeting will be held in the Multipurpose Room and is an opportunity to learn more about our programs, ask questions and receive some important information for the start of the new Faith Formation year. You may bring younger children along with you to this meeting.

## 9:00 a.m. Preschool/Kindergarten First Day of Class Information

If your child attends the Sunday 9:00 a.m. Pre/K class, please note that on the first day of class, we would like you to arrive at 8:40 a.m. This will give you and your child the opportunity to meet the teachers and get settled. Additionally, we will have a "Parent Packet" of information for you to pick up with specific details about our program. After the first day, children can be brought to their classroom approximately 10-15 minutes prior to the start of the 9:00 a.m. Mass.
